

**IT IS HEREBY ORDERED,** The Supreme Court Administrative Order issued on March 27, 2020, tolled all time limits in the Ohio Rules of Civil Procedure, but permitted Courts to issue their own orders regarding tolling of time.

As the Court has issued previous orders permitting fax and email submission of objections to the Magistrate's Decision and is filing the objections when received, this Court requires that any objections be filed within 14 days of the filing of a magistrate's decision, and any motions to set aside the magistrate's decision be filed within 10 days, pursuant to Local Rule DR31 and Civil Rule 53.

Additionally, the time limits for transcripts and supplemental objections are still in effect pursuant to Local Rule DR31. The Court finds that because of the nature of the issues involved in domestic relations cases, objections require immediate attention and the Court is permitted to set a specific schedule.
